Details: This award is open to book must have been published within the last year in the horror or dark fantasy genres. The awards feature 13 categories. Digital copies are generally accepted, though physical copies may be requested. Finalists are typically announced in February, and the winners are announced in May.

Details: This award goes to the illustrator of the most distinguished American picture book or children's book published during the preceding year. There is only one category. Each entry must submit one physical copy to the committee chair. Winners are announced in January during the ALA Youth Media Awards.

Details: Any independently published book, including those from self-published authors and university presses, published this year. The INDIES are distinguished by an intense judging process utilizing professional editors, booksellers, and librarians. Our final judging process sees each book evaluated by a librarian and a bookseller, the decision makers for millions of book buys a year. They carefully appraise finalist titles using the following criteria: editorial excellence, professional production, originality of the narrative, and the value the book adds to its genre. There are over 50 genres you can enter your title into. Must submit two physical copies. Finalists are announced in March and the final winners are announced in June.

Purple Dragonfly Contest winners will be notified during the last week of August for each year's contest

Details: The Christy and the Amplify Award for Christian Fiction was created by publishers and agents to elevate and recognize underrepresented ethnic stories of excellence, and their authors. All nominees for The Amplify Award must first be submitted into a traditional category of The Christy Award before opting to be considered for this additional award. The book must have been published within the last year. Submissions are accepted in nine fiction categories. Finalists are announced in September. Winners are announced in November.

All winners are announced in early February.

Details: There are no restrictions on publication dates. Books can be submitted as eBooks (PDF, epub or mobi files) and paper books. If submitting a paper book please submit a total of 3 books no matter the number of categories. There will be a first, second and third prize winner in both the fiction and non-fiction categories. There is the potential for there to be one winner in each of over 50 subcategories (genres), but only if the book receives a 4-5 star rating. All winners are announced end of May.

Winners are announced in November.
